Applying to SDSU Graduate Program is a two step process

Step 1. Apply to the University. You are required to submit the CSU application form to the SDSU office of Graduate Admissions. Application forms can be obtained from Graduate Admissions on any CSU campus and submit both application and \$55 fee to: Graduate Admissions, San Diego State University, 5500 Campanile Drive, San Diego, Ca 92182-8225. Electronic application is available at <http://www.csumentor.edu>

Step 2. Apply to the PLC Dept. Submit this application packet to the PLC Dept., **include the following:**

1. An application to the PLC Department (this form).
2. **Two sets of official transcripts** in sealed envelopes from each issuing institution. This includes all degree transcripts and transcripts from the last institution attended (bring or mail transcripts directly to the PLC Office). Do not include any extension course work.
3. Evidence of a bachelor's degree and a GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 units of coursework.
4. **An official copy of your GRE scores.**
5. Two letters of recommendation from persons, such as the director of the school or community facility where you are employed who are unrelated to you by family. If unemployed, solicit two letters of recommendation from persons who know you professionally.
6. A one page writing sample on why you wish to be admitted to the program.
7. A scheduled interview with the PLC department advisor or PLC Admissions Committee.
