Student Teaching Assignment/Essays

A) **AUTOBIOGRAPHY**

Please write a 1 1/2 page autobiography around the following three major topics. This information will help the school administrators, master teachers, and the University supervisor to become better acquainted with you.

1. Personal information relative to your birthplace, elementary schooling, interests, hobbies, etc.
2. Experiences you have had with elementary school children that have helped you gain insight into childhood growth and development and into school procedures and operations.
3. A brief statement indicating the reasons why you are interested in teaching and why you have the potential for becoming an excellent teacher.

B) **GOALS AND PHILOSOPHY**

A 1 1/2 page essay of professional goals and philosophy is required of all students wishing to enter the credential program. Please write an essay covering such areas as your professional development as an educator, the kind of skills you feel are necessary to be an effective bilingual teacher and your perceived type of support needed to accomplish the above. You may also wish to cover the importance of the language and culture children bring to school and its role in any further academic development.

C) **SUBMITTING ESSAYS**

Submit the original autobiography and goals and philosophy essay and seven additional sets each with the completed Student Teaching Assignment Cover Sheet.
