- a. Evidence that the formal organization has operated as a non profit, 501(c)3 for a minimum of two years
- b. Statement of names of officers or board directors and major staff, such as an executive director
- c. Evidence of fiscal responsibility, such as an audit, formal account reports, and/or evidence of activities consistent with SDPCA goals, such as the past year's annual report, and/or a year of newsletters and/ or minutes of board meetings.

Detail Info – Project Mini-Grant – (2 pages):

Proposal is to be for a specific project rather than ongoing expenses or general support. Include the following:

- a. Describe the specific project
- b. Show what results and outcomes are to be achieved
- c. Indicate the time frame for achieving the results (within two years)
- d. Include a budget for the project

If the proposal is funded, at the end of the proposed project the recipient organization should submit to the SDPCA a short report on the activity, how well it achieved its purpose, and on use of funds.

Detail Info – Global Awareness Award – (1 page):

SDPCA members may make Award nominations to honor organizations, which carry out work

consistent with the SDPCA's goals. Include the following:

- a. Describe the organization, i.e., what it does.
- b. Show what results the organization and its members are achieving or have achieved over the last two years.
- c. Explain what makes the organization and its members worthy of recognition.
