Requirements

Qualifying 970 A students will instruct small groups of English learners or students from diverse backgrounds who are struggling readers in the sixth grade from September 21th to December 18th three days a week (Monday, Tuesday, & Thursday) at a local middle school *during school hours*. Students who are not available to instruct during school hours at the designated school site are *not* eligible for this tuition money (note that this makes interns and many other district employees NOT eligible). Instruction will take place throughout the semester beginning with an in-service on two Saturdays, September 19 & 26.

Benefits

Qualifying 970A students will gain additional practice teaching reading and language arts, as well as a financial support package – consisting of full time SDSU registration fee support – for both the Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 semesters.

Application Process

Students who are interested in and eligible for the Project Achieve scholarship should complete and submit the application on the reverse of this flyer and submit it to the Special Education Department office by the stated deadline.
