



San Diego State University, School of Teacher Education Master's programs in Education for Spring 2010

You may have heard that there will be no new students admitted to our Master's programs for Spring 2010, but there is an opportunity for you to apply if you are finishing an STE credential program at SDSU this December 2009...

Steps to applying:

- Step 1. Take the Graduate Record Exam (GRE) – *please plan to take the exam before the end of October '09, so you will have your scores in time...***
To register for the General GRE exam, please call Thomson Prometric Testing Service at 858-866-2120 or the SDSU Test Office at 619-594-0968. You can also go online to <http://www.ets.org>
- Step 2. Complete a Classified Graduate Standing Form**
If you are currently enrolled as a graduate student (finishing a credential program), you are not required to re-apply to the University to start a Master's as long as you do not take a semester off in between these programs. You will need to submit a Classified Graduate Standing form along with your departmental application. The form is also available online at <http://gra.sdsu.edu/grad/classgradstand.html>
- Step 3. Apply to the Curriculum and Instruction or MAT Program.**
