Block classes include practical strategies of grading, testing, technology applications and classroom management, as well as many guest speakers who are current teachers and administrators. Knowledge of the California Standards for the Teaching Profession and CLAD applications are emphasized. Semester one includes student teaching at a Grossmont District high school; semester two includes student teaching at a La Mesa – Spring Valley middle school. Teaching assignments are scheduled during the mornings. Student evaluations of the program have been consistently very positive.
