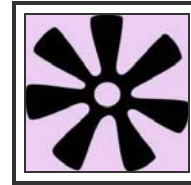

Phase 3: Individual Instructional Unit Evaluation Rubric

Your Individual Instructional Unit;	points
1) addresses all six questions; 2) is well-articulated, making creative and purposeful connections that fully exploit island resources; 3) aligns well with the Armaiti Island <i>Philosophy of Education</i> statement developed in Phase 1; 4) contains a thorough description of instructional events so that other educators may use the unit without the need for further explanation; 5) contains a clearly defined schedule of 4-5 hours of instruction (NOTE: You may divide this time any way you deem most appropriate.); 6) contains at least one evaluation rubric for learners that provides a thorough description of performance expectations, and; 7) is cohesive, uniform, aesthetically-pleasing and professional in appearance.	16-20
1) addresses all or most of the six questions and/or; 2) makes some connections that exploit island resources and/or; 3) partially aligns with the Armaiti Island <i>Philosophy of Education</i> statement developed in Phase 1 and/or; 4) contains a fairly thorough description of instructional events but other educators may not be able to use the unit without further explanation and/or; 5) contains a schedule of the 4-5 hours of instruction in which some of the timeframes are not clearly defined and/or; 6) lacks somewhat in cohesion, uniformity, aesthetic quality and overall professional appearance.	11-15
1) addresses all or some of the six questions and/or; 2) makes few or no meaningful connections that exploit island resources and/or; 3) reflects poor alignment with the Armaiti Island <i>Philosophy of Education</i> statement developed in Phase 1 and/or; 4) contains a description of instructional events that lacks sufficient detail for unit to be used by other educators without substantial additional explanation and/or; 5) contains a schedule of the 4-5 hours of instruction in which the timeframes are vague or confusing and/or; 6) lacks cohesion, uniformity, aesthetic quality and overall professional appearance.	0-10
